RE: Freedom of Access Request

Dear Mr. Nunes:

This is in response to your e-mail request to me and my Administrative Assistant sent March 7, 2018 with regard to written communications between the Bath Police Department and the Bath Iron Works regarding policing of protests at the Shipyard, from January 1, 2016 to the present. The document relating to the planning and communications between the Bath Police Department and the Bath Iron Works were related to security planning and procedures and risk assessment. As such, these are not public records and are exempted under the provisions of 1 M.R.S. Section 402(3)(L). I am not aware of any documentary communications with BIW and the Bath Police relating to the arrests.

In the interests of completeness, I have included with this response the Adult Public Access Form for three of the protesters arrested in 2017. None were filled out with respect to the other six protesters. Also included are the mug shots for seven of the protesters, and the BIW Christening Arrest Log. Also enclosed are Bath Police Department Press Release dated April 1, 2017 and an E-Mail from Lt. Robert Savary with a copy to Stanley Cielinski of BIW. This is an internal E-Mail indicating that manpower would be needed for the planned christening on April 1.

For the event in 2016, I have included twelve of the Adult Public Access Forms. Also enclosed are the Bath Police Department Press Release dated June 18, 2016 and an E-Mail from Stanley Cielinski of BIW to Lt. Robert Savary indicating the confirmed date the Christening of the USS Michael Monsoor.
